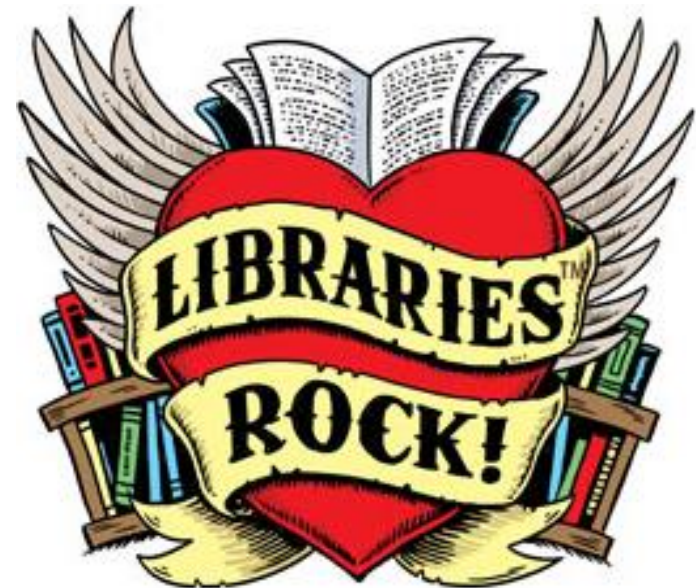
Scratch off the sticker for a chance to receive your prize immediately! Prizes include gift cards to local businesses, PopSockets, mini Pusheen plushies, and more.
